## Artwork for Portable Flag-Extender ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ flags

When you prepare the artwork, take your starting point in the drawings below.
A is the total width of the material incl. the space reserved for confectioning the flag.
B is the total width of the finished flag.
C is the width of the part of the flag flying freely.

The background colour of your document should extend all over the total width A of the flag (plus additions for cropping, if necessary). Depending on the design of the flag, your logo or image can be centered over the width B of the finished flag or over the width $C$ of the part flying freely. However, the distance $\mathbf{D}(13 \mathrm{~cm})$ in the left side of the flag should be kept free of complex designs so that confectioning does not interfere with the graphic.
